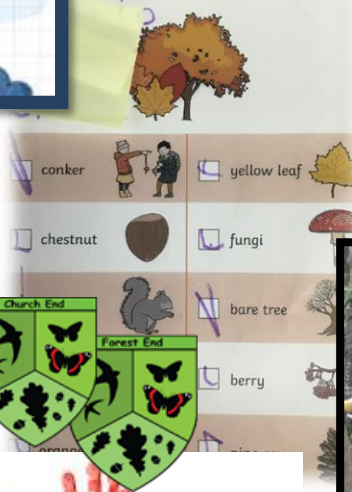

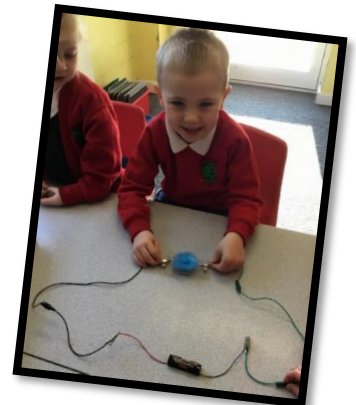

SPECIFIC AREA

Knowledge and Understanding of the World

Children talk about features of their own immediate environment and how the environment varies. They comment and ask questions about aspects of their familiar world.

Children can talk about why things happen and how things work.

Why do squirrels hide their nuts?

Do cows drink milk?



Children show care and concern for living things and the environment. They make observations of animals and explain why some things occur. Children made 'squirrel muffins and went on a trip to Mead Open
