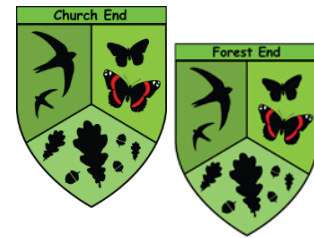

As we will be making assessments of your child's development in seven 'Areas of Learning', the questions below are arranged under these headings. We hope this will give you an indication of the breadth of the Early Years Foundation Stage curriculum.

Personal, Social and Emotional:

How does your child cope with new situations and unfamiliar people?

Is your child happy to play independently and/or join in play with others?

Can your child sometimes consider the feelings of others?

Communication and Language:

Does your child like to listen to stories?

Will s/he talk about things they like doing?

Have you any concerns about your child's speech?

Physical Development:

Is your child happy to run, climb and balance?

Is s/he confident using scissors and/or crayons?

Can your child put on his/her jumper and coat?

Is s/he beginning to understand some foods are 'good' for you?

Literacy:

Does your child like to look at books?

Does s/he like to try to write? Can they write their name?

Mathematics:

Is your child showing interest in counting and finding numbers?

Can s/he use language to compare sizes (big, biggest, long, short etc.)

Can s/he describe the position of an object (in front, behind, inside etc.)

Understanding the World:

Will your child talk about their home life and remember special events?

Will s/he observe plants / animals and talk about them?

Can your child operate mechanical toys or ICT equipment? (eg. TV, CD player, mobile phone, computer)

Expressive Arts and Design:

Does your child like to listen or dance to music? Will s/he sing any songs?

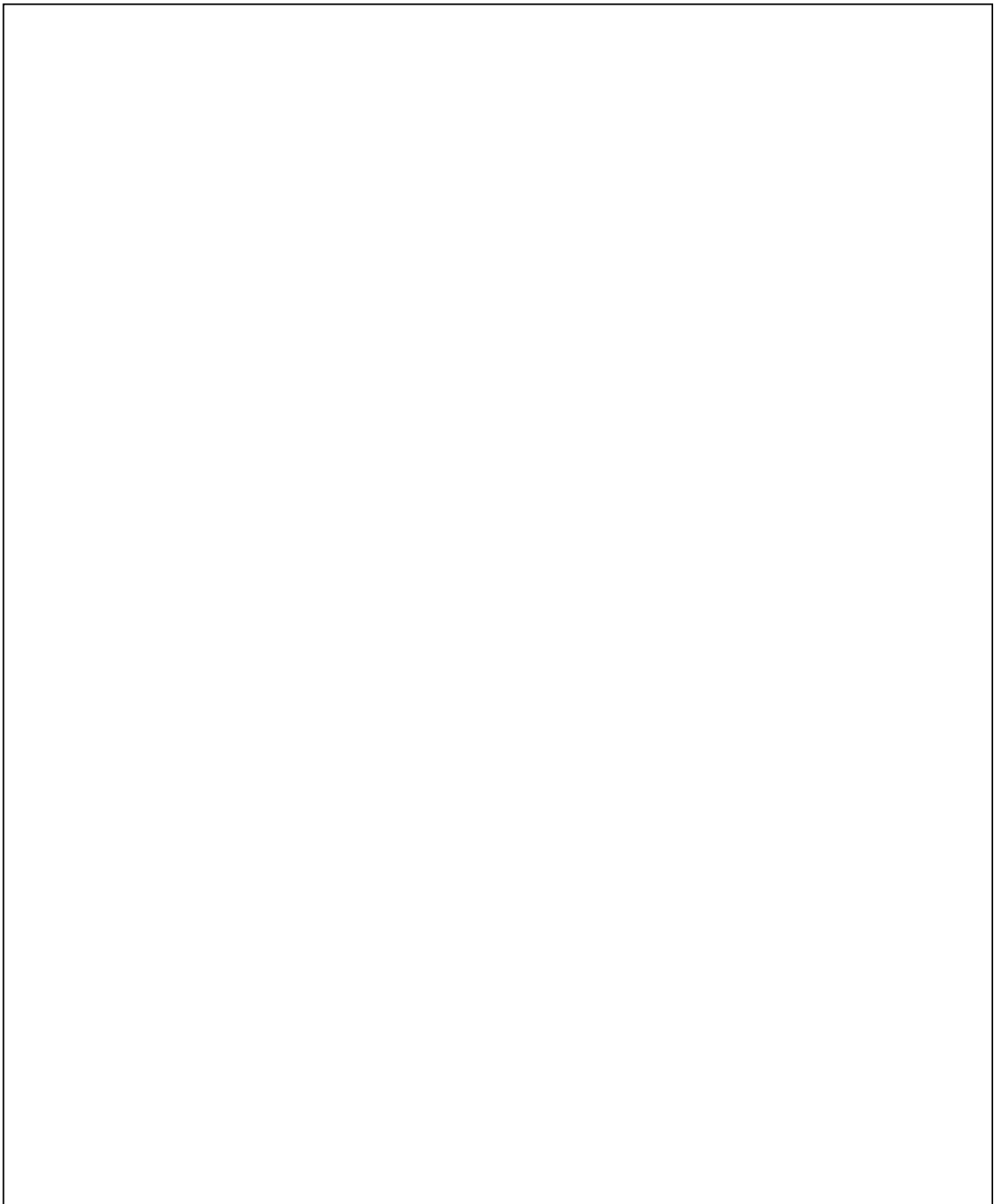
Does s/he like to build with construction kits? (eg. lego)
